Human Rights Amendment Bill

*Proposed motion to divide Bill into 2 Bills*

Hon Margaret Wilson, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2, Parts 1 and 3, and Schedules 1 to 3* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words and clauses 1 and 2 there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Human Rights Amendment Act **2001**.
- (2) In this Act, the Human Rights Act 1993 is called "the principal Act".

**2 Commencement**

- (1) This Act comes into force on **1 January 2002**.
- (2) Despite **subsection (1), sections 8(1)(ba), 13A, 14(1)(da), and 15A** of the principal Act (as inserted by **section 5** of this Act) and **section 141A(2)** of the principal Act (as inserted by **section 33A** of this Act) come into force on **1 July 2002**.

That *Part 2* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 2* heading, *clause 40*, and the heading above *clause 41* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the War Pensions Amendment Act **2001**.
- (2) In this Act, the War Pensions Act 1954 is called "the principal Act".

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
