AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR IN THE HUTT ROAD BILL.

PURSUANT to section 56 of the Constitution Act, the Governor returns to the House of Representatives the Bill intituled "An Act to provide for the Repair and Maintenance of the Hutt Road" with the following amendments, that is to say,—

In clause 6, subclause (6), omit "by-laws or."

In the same clause, omit subclause (7).

Add the following new subclause:—

(7.) The constructing authority may from time to time, with the approval of the Controlling Board, make by-laws with reference to the said road in the manner prescribed by "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1900"; and such by-laws shall have effect as if the same were made with reference to a street within the district of the constructing authority.
