HANSARD REPORT OF DEBATE IN COMMITTEE OF SUPPLY.

*Adjourned debate on the question, That the authority of this House be given to the Deputy-Speaker and the Acting Chairman of Committees to go through the reports of the speeches of the member for Bruce, and also of all members' speeches in *Hansard* in the discussion which took place in the House when in Committee of Supply on the evening of the 13th September, and delete from the said reports any repetitions of and all references to the words used by the honourable member for Bruce, and which said words were withdrawn by the said honourable member (*Rt. Hon. R. J. Seddon*); and the amendment proposed thereto, To omit all the words after the word "Committees," in line 2, and insert the following words in lieu thereof: "together with the particular members concerned, to revise the speeches of members delivered in Committee of Supply on the evening of the 13th September, and to delete from such speeches all repetitions, either in effect or otherwise, of the words used by the member for Bruce, and which said words were afterwards withdrawn" (*Mr. Massey*).
