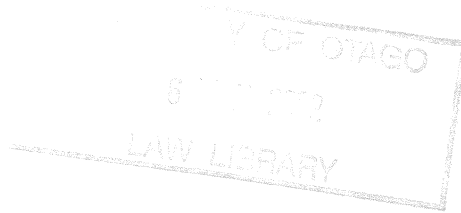

# Supplementary Order Paper

Wednesday, 1 May 2002

### Genetically Modified Organisms and Restricted Biotechnical Procedures Bill

*Proposed motion to divide Bill into 2 Bills*

Hon Marian Hobbs, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *clause 1 and Parts 1 and 2* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words and *clauses 1 and 2* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Hazardous Substances and New Organisms (Genetically Modified Organisms) Amendment Act 2002.
- (2) In this Act, the Hazardous Substances and New Organisms Act 1996<sup>1</sup> is called "the principal Act".

### Part 1

#### Preliminary provisions

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 3* be a separate Bill, and that for the heading to *Part 3* and *clause 10* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Medicines (Restricted Biotechnical Procedures) Amendment Act 2002.

- (2) In this Act, the Medicines Act 1981<sup>2</sup> is called “the principal Act”.

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
