INDUSTRIAL AND PROVIDENT SOCIETIES AMENDMENT BILL

Proposed Amendments

HON. MR McLAY, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 3: To omit from line 32 on page 2 the words "to the Registrar".

Clause 5: To omit from line 20 on page 6 the word "A", and substitute the word "The".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

BOTH of the proposed amendments are of a tidying-up nature.

Clause 3: The new section 5A (3) provides that no fee is payable to the Registrar in respect of the alteration of the rules of the Society if the alteration only changes the name of the society pursuant to the requirements of subsection (1) of the new section 5A. The reference to the Registrar is unnecessary as no fee would be payable to the Registrar in any event. It is accordingly proposed that the reference to the Registrar be omitted.

Clause 5: The proposed amendment changes a reference to "A Deputy Registrar" to a reference to "The Deputy Registrar" as there is provision in the Industrial and Provident Societies Act 1908 for only one Deputy Registrar of Industrial and Provident Societies.
