### **Identity (Citizenship and Travel Documents) Bill**

Motion to divide the Bill into 2 separate Bills

Hon George Hawkins, in Committee, to move the following motion:

That *clauses 1 and 2*, *Part 1*, and the *Schedule* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, *clauses 1 to 3*, and the *Part 1* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

#### The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title
- (1) This Act is the Citizenship Amendment Act **2005**.
- (2) In this Act, the Citizenship Act 1977 is called "the principal Act".

#### 2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 2* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 2* heading and *clause 18* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

#### The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title
- (1) This Act is the Passports Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, Passports Act 1992 is called "the principal Act".

#### 2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
