INDUSTRIAL CONCILIATION AND ARBITRATION ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Rt. Hon. R. J. SEDDON, in Committee, to move to add the following new clause, namely:—

2A. The definition of "Worker" in the principal Act is hereby repealed, and the following substituted in lieu thereof:—

"Worker" means any person of any age of either sex employed by any employer to do any skilled or unskilled manual or clerical work for hire or reward, but does not extend to any person employed in any agricultural or pastoral pursuit.
