INSPECTION OF MACHINERY BILL.

Hon. Mr. HALL-JONES, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 31: Add proviso:—

Provided that the Inspector may at any time cancel or suspend any certificate where he deems it necessary in the interests of the public safety so to do.

Clause 33: Substitute "issued" for "granted."

Clause 42: Add, after "stationary engine," in subclause (1), the words "other than a winding-engine as aforesaid."

New clause.

Constable may
enter and
inspect
certificates.

53A. (1.) Any constable may enter upon any premises in which machinery is working and inspect the certificate in respect of the machinery and boiler respectively, and the certificate of the person in charge of an engine or boiler.

(2.) Every person required by this Act to be the holder of a certificate shall at all times while in charge of an engine or boiler have his certificate available for inspection by any constable, and shall, on the request of the constable, produce the same to him.

(3.) Every person who commits a breach of the *last-preceding* subsection is liable to a penalty not exceeding *five* pounds.
