LICENSING ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. ELL, in Committee, to move the following new clauses:—

Repeal of subsection (1) of section 37 of "The Licensing Act, 1881." Subsection one of section thirty-seven of "The Licensing Act, 1881," is hereby repealed.

Section 24 of "The Alcoholic Liquors Sale Control Act, 1895," amended. Section twenty-four of "The Alcoholic Liquors Sale Control Act Amendment Act, 1895," is hereby repealed, and the following substituted in lieu thereof, that is to say,—

"If any person supplies any liquor to any male aboriginal native who is under the influence of liquor, or sells or in any way gives or supplies, or allows to be sold, given, or supplied, any liquor to any female aboriginal native whomsoever, he commits an offence, and is liable to a penalty of not less than *two* nor more than *ten* pounds: Provided that this section shall not apply to any female aboriginal native being the wife of a European."
