LICENSING BILL.

Mr. PIRANI, in Committee, to move the following new clauses:—

Bottle licenses
abolished.

(1.) No bottle license shall be granted or renewed after the passing of this Act.

(2.) The words "bottle licenses" in section twenty-nine of "The Licensing Act, 1881," and also section thirty-three of the said Act, and that part of the First Schedule to the said Act under the heading "Bottle License," are hereby repealed.

Conditional
licenses,
abolished.

(1.) No conditional license shall be granted after the passing of this Act.

(2.) The words "conditional licenses" in section twenty-nine of "The Licensing Act, 1881," and also section thirty-six of the said Act, and that part of the First Schedule to the said Act under the heading "Conditional License," are hereby repealed.

Definition of
"bonâ fide
traveller"
amended.

The definition of "*bonâ fide* traveller" contained in section one hundred and fifty-seven of "The Licensing Act, 1881," is hereby amended by striking out the word "three," and inserting the word "five" in lieu thereof.
