LANDS FOR SETTLEMENT BILL.

Mr. PIRANI, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clause:—

Where in any part of the colony there are several estates suitable for the purposes specified in section *four*, such estates shall only be subject to compulsory taking in the following order, that is to say:—

- (1.) Estates unimproved or capable of such further improvement as will greatly increase their producing capacity;
- (2.) Estates the owners whereof do not reside in the colony;
- (3.) Highly-improved estates.

And so long as there shall be estates of the first and second class in the same part of the colony suitable for the purposes specified in section *four*, lands of the third class shall not be compulsorily taken.
