LANDS IMPROVEMENT AND NATIVE LANDS ACQUISITION BILL.

Hon. Mr. McKENZIE, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 4: Line 8, omit the word "person," and insert "association of working-men."

Clause 5: Line 14, omit the word "person," and insert "association of working-men." In line 18, omit the words "that prescribed in the said Act," and insert "two hundred acres for each member of such association."

Clause 8: Line 31, omit the words "thence transferred," and insert "credited." In line 32, omit the words "the credit of."

Clause 12: Line 4, after the word "pounds" insert "shall, as and when raised, be paid into the Public Account, and be credited by the Treasury to a separate account called 'The Native Lands Purchase Account.'"

Clause 12: Line 4, before the words "are applicable" insert—

13. The moneys in the said Native Land Purchase Account.

Strike out clause 13, and insert the following new clause, to follow new clause 13:—

14. The payments so authorised as aforesaid shall be deemed to include the cost of constructing roads and bridges to give access to Native lands purchased under any of the hereinbefore-mentioned Acts, and also the cost of administering these Acts and this Act.
