LAND LAWS AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Sir W. J. STEWARD, in Committee, to move the following amendments :—

Clause 47, line 43: To add after the word "creamery" the words "or for a church, manse, or parsonage, and for a glebe in connection therewith, or for any other purpose which in the opinion of the said Board and the said Minister renders such a sale expedient in the public interest."

[NOTE.—The above is in substitution of the notice *re* clause 47 which appears on Supplementary Order Paper No. 12.]

To insert new clause :—

73A. Section sixty-four of the principal Act is hereby amended as follows, namely :—

(a.) By adding at the end of subsection one thereof the following words: "or for public halls, libraries, drill-sheds, gymnasia, hospitals, or charitable institutions, or for manses or parsonages and glebes in connection therewith":

(b.) By substituting in lieu of subsection two thereof the following :—

"(2.) The area so disposed of shall not exceed five acres in the case of a dairy factory, creamery, or glebe, or one acre in any other case."
