LAND LAWS AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. FLATMAN, in Committee, to move the following amendments :—

Clause 39, lines 46 and 47 : To strike out the words “ or surface sow in grass.”

To add the following new clause :—

Holder of
pasturage lease
may sow his
run with grasses
or clover.

39A. (1.) The holder of any such pasturage lease or license may, with the consent of the Land Board and the Minister, surface sow the whole or any part of his run with grasses or clover.

(2.) The portion of the run so sown as aforesaid shall be specially valued in the same manner as is provided by section two hundred and seven of the principal Act at the termination of the lease or license, and the value of such grassing as determined by valuation shall be paid over by the incoming lessee to the outgoing lessee as therein provided, in addition to the value of the improvements provided for by the said section.
