LAND LAWS AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. HORNSBY, in Committee, to move the following amendments :—

To add the following new clause:—

A. The holder of any lease of land from any person, except where such land is held in trust for any institution or corporation of a religious, charitable, or educational character, shall have the right, after giving twelve months' notice to the owner of the land so leased, to convert such lease into a freehold on a basis of value to be determined by a Board to be composed of one valuer appointed by the owner of the land, one valuer appointed by the tenant, and a referee appointed by the two valuers aforesaid.

To amend clause 19A, given notice of by Mr. Massey :—

Subclause (b) : To strike out all the words after " be the owner," with a view to inserting the words " of any other land either leasehold or freehold."

Subclause (c) : To insert the word " original " between the words " the capital." To strike out all the words after the word " value " in the second line of the subclause down to the word " lease."
