### LAND LAWS AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Sir W. J. STEWARD, in Committee, to move the following new clause :—

Cropping  
regulations.

A. Notwithstanding anything in section forty-nine of the Land Act, 1882, contained, it shall be lawful for the Board to modify or vary the conditions imposed in any lease or by any regulations issued under the authority of the said Act or its amendments, or of the Land for Settlements Consolidation Act, 1900, or its amendments (in so far as regards the cropping, cultivating, clearing, or laying down in grass of any land) in such manner as it deems expedient in view of the circumstances of any particular case or of the conditions obtaining in any particular locality.
