### MEIKLE ACQUITTAL BILL.

Right Hon. Sir J. G. WARD, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

Preamble: To insert, after the word "Court" in line 10, the following words:—

"And whereas upon his discharge from prison the said John James Meikle commenced proceedings for perjury against one William Lambert, the chief witness for the prosecution on the trial of the said John James Meikle; and the said William Lambert was, in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five, at the sittings of the Supreme Court then held at Invercargill, convicted accordingly of perjury in respect of the evidence so given by him against the said John James Meikle, and was sentenced to imprisonment for the term of four years:—"
