NATIVE LAND ADMINISTRATION AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. PARATA, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

To add the following new subsection to clause 9, after subclause 10:—

As to section three thereof: By repealing the words “by Maoris” in the definition of “Maori.”

And, as to the same section, by repealing paragraph (c.) of the definition of “Maori land,” and substituting in lieu thereof the following: “(c.) Land owned by Maoris in the Middle Island or Stewart Island, or any other lands controlled by any other special Act.”

WHAKATIKATIKA I TE TURE WHAKAHAERE I NGA WHENUA MAORI.

T. PARATA, ka motini, ina uru ki te Komiti te Pire Whakatikatika i te Ture Whakahaere i nga Whenua Maori:—

Me apiti atu te wahanga-tekiona hou e whai ake nei ki tekiona 9 ki muri o wahanga-tekiona 10, ara:—

Mo tekiona toru o taua Ture ano: Me whakakore nga kupu nei “o te taha Maori” i roto i te whakamaramatanga o te kupu nei “Maori.” A i taua tekiona ano me whakore a rarangi (c) o te whakamaramatanga o te kupu nei “Whenua Maori,” a me hoatu hei whakakapi i tera ko tenei e whai ake nei, “Nga whenua kei nga Maori a kei Te Waipounamu me Stewart Island e takoto ana, me era atu whenua e whakahaerea ana i raro i tetahi Ture Motuhake.”
