MAORI LAND CLAIMS ADJUSTMENT AND LAWS FURTHER AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. MAJOR, in Committee, to move the following new clause :—

A. To give effect to the recommendation of the Native Affairs Committee of the Legislative Council, bearing date the eighth day of November, nineteen hundred and five, on petition of Ngahina Tokau and others, of Opunake, it is hereby declared that, notwithstanding any Act to the contrary, any person claiming an interest may, within two months after the passing of this Act, appeal to the Appellate Court against the order of that Court appointing successors to the late Wiremu Kingi Matakatea; and the said Appellate Court may hear and determine the said appeal, and cancel or vary the previous order of the Appellate Court, and so determine who are the rightful successors of the said Wiremu Kingi Matakatea.
