Proposed Amendment

Hon. Mr McLachlan, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

Clause 65: To omit this clause, and substitute the following clause:

65. Appointment and dismissal of officers and employees of the Corporation—Subject to this Act, the Corporation may, from time to time,—

(a) Appoint such officers and employees, including apprentices and temporary and probationary officers and employees, as it considers necessary for the efficient exercise of its functions; and

(b) In accordance with the Corporation's terms and conditions of employment, remove any such officer or employee from his office or employment.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This clause makes it clear that the Corporation's powers to appoint and remove staff are subject to all other provisions of the Bill (including those referring to other Acts), and, in so far as the power to remove staff is concerned, are also to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of employment of the Corporation.
