OLD-AGE PENSIONS AMENDMENT BILL.

Rt. Hon. R. J. SEDDON, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

In clause 16, to omit all words after "death of any pensioner," and substitute the following: "or of the wife or husband of any pensioner, it is found that he or either of them was possessed of property in excess of what is allowed by law in respect of the amount of the pension granted, the amount of pension at any time paid in excess of that to which the pensioner was by law entitled may be recovered as a debt due to the Crown from the estate so found in excess."
