OLD-AGE PENSIONS AMENDMENT BILL.

Right Hon. Sir J. G. WARD, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 2: Omit the word “proviso,” and substitute “provisoes”; add the following words:—

“Provided further that no pension shall be granted in excess of the sum allowed by computing the amount thereof either under paragraph (a) or paragraph (b) hereof, whichever provides for the greater deduction.”

Clause 5: Omit the word “capital” in line 27; and insert, after the word “resides” in line 28, the words “(other than property conveyed or transferred to the Public Trustee under section eleven hereof).”

Add the following new clause:—

Limitation of
section 15 of
principal Act.

5A. Nothing in section fifteen of the principal Act shall authorise the grant of a pension of a greater amount than is provided by section nine of that Act as amended by this Act.
