### PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS BILL.

Hon. Sir W. J. STEWARD, in Committee, to move the following new clauses:—

4. The twenty-fourth day of May (being Empire Day) and the Saturday next following Good Friday are hereby declared to be public and bank holidays, and the provisions of any Acts relating or applying to public or bank holidays (including the Shops and Shop Assistants Act, 1894, and the Factories Act, 1901, and its amendments) shall be deemed to apply to such before-mentioned days.

5. The Schedule of the Bank Holidays Act, 1902, is hereby consequentially amended by omitting therefrom "The Prince of Wales's Birthday," and substituting therefor "Empire Day, being the twenty-fourth day of May."

6. Section 33 of the Factories Act, 1901, is hereby consequentially amended by adding, in the second line of subsection (1) thereof next after the words "Good Friday," the words "the Saturday next following Good Friday," and by adding, next after the words "Labour Day," the words "Empire Day, being the twenty-fourth day of May."
