

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

Clause 19: The proposed amendment provides that if an Inspector orders any premises that are used for the wholesale or retail sale of food and that are registered under regulations in force under the Health Act 1956, he may inspect any poultry, eggs and poultry products on the premises but may not inspect the premises themselves.

Clause 7: This clause provides that certain premises are to be treated in the same way as premises that are used for the wholesale or retail sale of food and that are registered under regulations in force under the Health Act 1956.

### POULTRY BILL

#### *Proposed Amendments*

Hon. Mr TALBOYS, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

*Clause 5:* To add to subclause (1) the following proviso:

“Provided that nothing in this subsection shall authorise an Inspector to inspect any premises or part of any premises that are—

- “(a) Used for the wholesale or retail sale of food; and
- “(b) For the time being registered under any regulations for the time being in force under the Health Act 1956.”

*Clause 7:* To add the following subclause:

“(6) Nothing in this section shall apply to any premises that are—

- “(a) Used for the wholesale or retail sale of food; and
- “(b) For the time being registered under any regulations for the time being in force under the Health Act 1956.”

*Clause 19:* To omit paragraph (a) of subclause (1), and to substitute the following paragraph:

- “(a) Prescribing the requirements and conditions that must be complied with in relation to the hygiene of—
  - “(i) Premises where live poultry is kept, held, or raised;
  - “(ii) Premises where hatching-eggs are produced, handled, stored, or incubated;
  - “(iii) Premises (other than premises that are used for the wholesale or retail sale of food and that are for the time being registered under any regulations for the time being in force under the Health Act 1956) where eggs or poultry products intended for sale are handled, processed, graded, canned, packaged, held, or stored:”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*Clause 5:* The proposed amendment provides that, if an Inspector enters any premises that are used for the wholesale or retail sale of food and that are registered under regulations in force under the Health Act 1956, he may inspect any poultry, eggs, and poultry products on the premises but may not inspect the premises themselves.

*Clause 7:* This clause provides that certain premises are to be kept in a hygienic condition.

The amendment provides that the clause will not apply to premises that are used for the wholesale or retail sale of food and that are registered under regulations in force under the Health Act 1956.

*Clause 19:* The amendment provides that regulations relating to hygiene of premises may not be made in respect of the type of premises referred to above.

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
