

SUPPLEMENTARY ORDER PAPER.

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

Tuesday, the 29th day of July, 1873.

Mr. BUNNY to move, in Committee, the following amendments to the Provincial Councils Powers Bill :—

In line 1 of the preamble, after the word “the,” to insert “second subsection to clause ;” and in the same line to strike out the word “nineteenth,” and insert “nineteen” and to strike out “section.”

In the second subsection of the preamble to strike out “For.”

To strike out the next four paragraphs of the preamble, from line 11 on the first page to line 38 on the second page, and to insert the words, “And whereas it is expedient to repeal such second sub-section, and also to repeal ‘The Provincial Councils Powers Act, 1856.’”

To insert new clause 2: “The Provincial Councils Powers Act, 1856,” is hereby repealed.

To insert new clause 3: The second subsection to the nineteenth clause of the Constitution Act is hereby repealed.

Old clause 2 to stand as clause 4.

The remaining clauses and Schedule to be struck out.
