PURE FOOD BILL.

Hon. Mr. FOWLDS, in Committee, to move the following amendments :—

Clause 7, subclause (1) : Omit the words “or the person in whose possession the article was at the time the sample was procured, or the person from whom the sample was procured.”

Clause 7, subclause (2) : In line 18 omit the word “article,” and substitute the word “sample” ; in line 21 omit the words “or other person as aforesaid.”

Clause 12 : Insert new subclause as follows :—

(5A.) Every person commits an offence who sells any food which is unsound or unfit for human consumption.

Clause 22 : Add new subclause as follows :—

(3.) For the purposes of this Act every person shall be deemed to sell or to intend to sell any food or drug if he sells or intends to sell for human consumption any article of which such food or drug is a constituent.

Clause 26 : Insert after “food,” in line 27 and again in line 31, the words “or drug” ; omit the word “food” in line 33, and substitute “any food or drug” ; insert after “food,” in line 40, the words “or drugs.”

Clause 28, subclause (1) : Insert after “Acts” the words “and parts of Acts.”

Schedule : Add—

1900, No. 25.—The Public Health Act, 1900 : Section 87.

1903, No. 82.—The Public Health Amendment Act, 1903 : Section 10.
