PUBLIC HEALTH ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. WITTY, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

Removal of
building from
one district to
another.

A. (1.) It shall not be lawful to remove from the district under the jurisdiction of any local authority any building, or part of a building, or any materials of which any building was composed, and re-erect the same or use the same in the erection of any building within any other district without the consent of the local authority of such last-mentioned district.

(2.) Every person who commits a breach of this section is liable to a fine not exceeding *one* hundred pounds, and the building or part thereof erected contrary to the provisions hereof shall be deemed to be an insanitary building, and may be dealt with under section eleven of the Public Health Amendment Act, 1903, without the necessity for the certificate of the District Health Officer as therein mentioned.
