#### PUBLIC HEALTH AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. BOLLARD, in Committee, to move the following new clauses :—

It shall not be lawful for any person to use any land or place in any district as a site for the disposal, treatment, or deposit of nightsoil or refuse brought from any other district without first obtaining the consent in writing of the local authority of the district into which it is proposed to bring such nightsoil or refuse.

Such consent may be granted at a special meeting of the local authority convened for the purpose, and such special meeting shall be notified by at least two advertisements in a newspaper or newspapers circulating in the district into which it is proposed to bring such nightsoil or refuse, not less than seven days and not more than twenty-eight days before the holding of the special meeting.

Every person who brings or is concerned in bringing any nightsoil or refuse from one district into another district, or who uses any land or place in any district for the deposit, disposal, or treatment of nightsoil or refuse, without having first obtained the consent in writing of the local authority of the district into which such nightsoil or refuse is brought, is liable, on conviction, for a first offence to a penalty not exceeding *five* pounds or, in default, to imprisonment for a period not exceeding *fourteen* days, and for any subsequent offence to a penalty not exceeding *fifty* pounds or, in default, to imprisonment for a period not exceeding *six* months.
