PUBLIC RESERVES BILL.

Mr. MILLAR, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

To strike out the last proviso in section 24 of "The Public Reserves Act, 1881."

To insert the following new clause:—

The Colonial Secretary shall not grant any permit to use the totalisator at any race meeting held or proposed to be held on any public reserve except under the provisions of clause twenty-four of the principal Act.

RATING ON UNIMPROVED VALUE BILL (No 2).

Hon. Major STEWARD, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clause:—

Lands set apart for or devoted exclusively to purposes of public recreation (including cricket-grounds, football-grounds, race-courses, lawn-tennis courts, and croquet-grounds) shall be exempt from rating under the principal Act.
