PUBLIC SERVICE SUPERANNUATION BILL.

Right Hon. Sir J. G. WARD, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 2: To omit from the definition of Public Service all the words after "Teachers' Superannuation Act, 1905," in line 7.

Clause 33: To insert the words "without further appropriation than this Act" after the words "Consolidated Fund" in line 37, and to omit the first-mentioned words in lines 38 and 39.

Clause 37: To insert after paragraph (c) the following paragraph:—

(cc.) The members of the defence forces under the Defence Act, 1886, except the Permanent Militia and other persons permanently employed in the said forces.

To add the following new clause:—

Superannuation 41. Section eleven of the Appropriation Act, 1887, is hereby allowance under repealed as from the first day of April, nineteen hundred and eight; and, in the case of any person who retires from the Civil Service after that date, any superannuation allowance to which he is entitled under the Civil Service Act, 1866, shall be calculated in the same manner as if the said section had not been passed.
