PETONE WATER-SUPPLY CONSERVATION BILL.

Hon. Mr. McNab, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

First Schedule: In line 3, to omit the words "Lands and Survey Office," and substitute therefor the words "office of the Chief Surveyor at"; and in line 5, to add after the word "reserve" the following words: "as shown upon a plan numbered 42/67, deposited in the office of the Chief

Surveyor, at Wellington."

Second Schedule: In line 1, after the words "situate in," to insert the words "Block VIII of"; in line 2, to omit the words "on the plan"; in line 3, to omit the word "Estate," and substitute therefor the word "Settlement"; in line 3, to omit the words "deposited in the Lands and Survey Office, at Wellington," and substitute therefor the words "as shown upon plans numbered respectively 42/68 and 42/69, deposited in the office of the Chief Surveyor, at Wellington."

Third Schedule: In line 1, to insert after the words "situate in" the words "Block VIII of"; in line 2, to omit the words "on the plan"; in line 2, to omit the word "Estate," and substitute therefor the word "Settlement"; in lines 2 and 3, to omit the words "deposited in the Lands and Survey Office, at Wellington," and substitute therefor the words "as shown upon the aforesaid plans numbered respectively 42/68 and 42/69, deposited in the office of the Chief Surveyor, at Wellington."
