RAILWAYS BILL.

Mr. BUICK, in Committee, to move :---

1. The officers of the railway service shall be divided into three classes— (1) Clerical, (2) Technical, (3) Manual.

2. No person shall be appointed to the Clerical Class save as officers are appointed in other clerical departments of the service.

3. No person shall be appointed to the Technical Class save as experts are appointed in other departments of the Government service, or as cadets.

4. Regulations shall be framed by the Governor in Council for the appointment of cadets to the Technical Class, who shall be nominated by members of the House of Representatives in alphabetical order. No member shall have the right to a second nomination until every other member has had the opportunity of nominating one cadet.

5. No person shall be appointed to the Technical Class unless he has passed the Fourth Standard of education or its equivalent.

6. No person shall be appointed to the Manual Class save on the nomination of the District Manager.
