REPRESENTATION BILL.

The Hon. Sir R. Stout, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

That subsection (3) of section 3 be amended to read as follows :

- (3.) The extent of the several districts shall respectively be such that not more than one member, save as hereinafter provided, shall be assigned to each district, and that in no case whatever at the time of making any such division shall the population as aforesaid of any district, not a borough or city, fall short of or exceed the quota by more than five hundred, and of any district where the borough or city is a single electorate shall not exceed the quota by one thousand votes, and where districts are amalgamated, by the multiple of one thousand by the number of members.
