REPRESENTATION BILL.

Mr. M. J. S. MACKENZIE, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

When the Commissioners have decided to alter an existing electoral district, and the boundaries of the new district are provisionally determined, due notice of such proposed boundaries, or an approximation thereto, shall be given in any newspaper published or circulating within such district, and a day appointed for one or more of the Commissioners to receive any objections that may in writing be lodged against such proposed boundaries, and the Commissioners shall give full consideration to such objections before coming to a final determination.
