STAMP ACTS AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Sir J. VOGEL to move the following addition to the 5th clause:—

Stamp duties  
under Sections  
24 and 25 of  
"The Native  
Land Admini-  
stration Act,  
1886," when  
payable.

In respect of land for which a title is obtained under or by virtue of the twenty-fourth and twenty-fifth sections of "The Native Land Administration Act, 1886," the several duties chargeable under "The Stamp Act 1882 Amendment Act, 1885," shall be due and payable as soon as the land becomes vested by conveyance on sale or by lease in the purchaser or lessee respectively, and section forty-six of "The Stamp Act, 1882," shall apply thereto accordingly.

Nothing in this section contained shall establish any claim to a refund of any stamp duties or penalties already paid.

LOCAL BODIES' FINANCE AND POWERS BILL.

Mr. G. F. RICHARDSON, on the order for the third reading, to move,—

That the said order be discharged, with a view to the recommittal of this Bill for consideration of the following new clause:—

. The Schedule to the said Act is hereby further amended by the omission of the words "nor greater than two thousand pounds" in subsection (b) (2) of the said Schedule.

Mr. SMITH to move:—

. That, in respect of counties where there are road districts and the Counties Act is in full force therein—

Then the subsidy payable to the County Council under subsection (b) of section (c) in the Schedule of the said Act shall be payable on the general rates actually collected by such County Council:

Provided that no greater sum than five thousand pounds shall be paid in any one year under this clause to any such County Council.
