SCHOOL ATTENDANCE BILL.

Mr. PIRANI, in Committee, to move the following new clause and amendments:—

No child shall attend a public school under the control of an Education Board in any district other than the school district in which his parents or guardians reside, unless the Chairman of the School Committee or the head-teacher of a school in the district in which his parents or guardians reside has given a certificate under his hand consenting to such attendance.

Clause 5: After the word "Peace," in the 47th line, insert "may be summoned before any Justice of the Peace at the school at which such attendance is compulsory."

Clause 7: Before the words "and in," in the 15th line, insert "provided that the cases may be heard before one Justice of the Peace at the school at which such attendance is compulsory."
