STATUTES AMENDMENT BILL (NO. 2)

Proposed Amendments

Hon. J. K. McLay, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

That clauses 2 and 3 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 2 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Education Act 1964

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Education Amendment Act (No. 3) 1982, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Act 1964 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That *clauses 4 to 6* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 4* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Government Life Insurance Act 1953

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Government Life Insurance Amendment Act 1982, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Government Life Insurance Act 1953 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That clauses 7 and 8 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 7 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the New Zealand Society of Accountants Act 1958

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the New Zealand Society of Accountants Amendment Act 1982, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the New Zealand Society of Accountants Act 1958 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That *clauses 9 and 10* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 9* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Property Law Act 1952

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Property Law Amendment Act (No. 2) 1982, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Property Law Act 1952 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
