Statutes Amendment Bill (No 4)

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 26 Bills

Hon Rick Barker, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2, and Part 1A* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, *clauses 1, 2, and 4A*, and the *Part 1A* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Armed Forces Discipline Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the Armed Forces Discipline Act 1971¹ is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 2* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 2* heading and *clause 5* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Conservation Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the Conservation Act 1987² is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 2A* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 2A* heading and *clause 6A* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Constitution Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the Constitution Act 1986³ is called “the principal Act”.

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 2B* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 2B* heading and *clause 6E* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Defence Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the Defence Act 1990⁴ is called “the principal Act”.

That *Part 3* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 3* heading and *clause 7* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

- (1) This Act is the Electoral Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the Electoral Act 1993⁵ is called “the principal Act”.

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 4* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 4* heading and *clause 9* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Evidence Amendment Act 2005.

2 Commencement

- (1) **Section 10** comes into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council.
- (2) The rest of this Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 5* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 5* heading and *clauses 11 and 12* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Fire Service Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the Fire Service Act 1975⁶ is called “the principal Act”.

- (1) This Act is the Forest and Rural Fires Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the Forest and Rural Fires Act 1977⁷ is called “the principal Act”.

- (1) This Act is the Geneva Conventions Amendment Act 2005.

- (2) In this Act, the Geneva Conventions Act 1958⁸ is called “the principal Act”.

- (1) This Act is the Government Superannuation Fund Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the Government Superannuation Fund Act 1956⁹ is called “the principal Act”.

- (1) This Act is the Health and Disability Services (Safety) Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the Health and Disability Services (Safety) Act 2001¹⁰ is called “the principal Act”.

- (1) This Act is the Judicature Amendment Act 2005.

- (1) This Act is the Medicines Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the Medicines Act 1981¹⁴ is called “the principal Act”.

- (1) This Act is the Motor Vehicle Sales Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the Motor Vehicle Sales Act 2003¹⁵ is called “the principal Act”.

That *Part 13* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 13* heading and *clause 70* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the National Parks Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the National Parks Act 1980¹⁶ is called “the principal Act”.

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 14 and Schedule 2* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 14* heading and *clause 72* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the New Zealand Public Health and Disability Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the New Zealand Public Health and Disability Act 2000¹⁷ is called “the principal Act”.

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 15* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 15* heading and *clause 76* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

- (1) This Act is the Ngāi Tahu Claims Settlement Amendment Act 2005.

- (2) In this Act, the Ngāi Tahu Claims Settlement Act 1998¹⁸ is called “the principal Act”.

- (1) This Act is the Patriotic and Canteen Funds Amendment Act 2005.

- (2) In this Act, the Patriotic and Canteen Funds Act 1947¹⁹ is called “the principal Act”.

- (1) This Act is the Racing Amendment Act 2005.

- (2) In this Act, the Racing Act 2003²⁰ is called “the principal Act”.

- (1) This Act is the Reserves Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the Reserves Act 1977²² is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 18A* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 18A* heading and *clause 85A* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Sale of Liquor Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the Sale of Liquor Amendment Act 2004²³ is called “the principal Act”.

This Act is deemed to have come into force on the commencement of section 14 of the principal Act.

That *Part 19* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 19* heading and *clause 86* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Telecommunications Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the Telecommunications Act 2001²⁴ is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 20* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 20* heading and *clause 89* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Trade in Endangered Species Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the Trade in Endangered Species Act 1989²⁵ is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
