UNCLAIMED LANDS BILL.

Hon. Mr. WARD, in Committee, to move the following new clause :—

22A. Where, under this Act, the Public Trustee shall become the registered proprietor, under "The Land Transfer Act, 1885," or its amendments, of any land or real estate, then the Assurance Fund shall not be liable to compensate any person having any estate or interest in such land or real estate existing at the time the Public Trustee becomes such registered proprietor.

SHIPPING AND SEAMEN'S ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. REEVES, in Committee, to move the following new proviso to clause 5:—

Provided also that the Minister, by writing under his hand, may dispense with such deposit in the case of foreign vessels where he is satisfied that the Consul or other duly-authorized representative in New Zealand of the foreign country to which such vessel belongs is prepared to make provision to the satisfaction of the Minister for any seaman discharged from such vessel.
