HAWKERS AND PEDLARS.

Mr. Houston to move on going into Committee,—

In the interpretation clause, after the word “person,” in the 4th line, on page 2, to add the following words: “whether on his own behalf or representing a wholesale or retail house.”

And after the word “colony,” in the 9th line, on same page, to add the following words: “or makes a house-to-house canvass.”

After the word “comprised,” in the 21st line, on page 2, to add the following words: “Commercial traveller means and shall apply to any person who represents a wholesale house and solicits orders only from those who are engaged in trade.”

After clause 34, page 7, to add the following words: “But this shall not apply to commercial travellers.”

SHOPS AND SHOP-ASSISTANTS BILL.

Mr. Willis to move on going into Committee,—

At the end of clause 3 to add—

Whenever any day in any week shall be observed as a holiday or a half-holiday, then it shall not be incumbent on the proprietor of any shop to observe the half-holiday provided by this Act.
