STAMP DUTIES AMENDMENT BILL.

Right Hon. Sir J. G. Ward, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

Insert the following new clause:—

Duty imposed on
certain other
revenues of
racing clubs.

2A. (1.) The duty of two and a half per centum imposed by section one hundred and forty-two of the principal Act as amended by this Act on the gross takings of totalisators is hereby also imposed on the gross amount received at any race-meeting by any horse-racing club, racing committee, or racing association authorised to use the totalisator, by way of payments for admission to the racecourse or to any part thereof, or by way of fees payable on any licenses granted to any person in respect of that race-meeting.

(2.) This section shall apply to every race-meeting held after the commencement of this Act or in progress at the commencement of this Act.

(3.) All the provisions of sections one hundred and forty-two, one hundred and forty-three, and one hundred and forty-four of the principal Act (including the penal provisions thereof) shall, so far as applicable, extend and apply to the duty imposed by this section, and to the revenues on which that duty is imposed, in the same manner as in the case of the duty and revenues referred to in those sections.
