#### SALE OF LIQUOR AMENDMENT BILL (NO. 2)

### **Proposed Amendment**

MR EAST, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

Proposed new clause 20B: To add on page 13 the following new clause:

**20B.** Special provisions relating to general ancillary licences converted to club licences—(1) Part I of the Sale of Liquor Amendment Act 1980 is hereby amended by inserting, after section 60, the following section:

"60A. (1) This section applies to every licence that, by virtue of subsection (2) of section 60 of this Act, is converted into a club licence, where—

"(a) The holder of the licence is not a club; and

"(b) The licence to which the premises relates is used for any sporting or recreational activity by members of the public.

"(2) The provisions of the principal Act relating to club licences shall apply to every licence to which this section applies as if—

"(a) The holder of the licence were a club; and

"(b) The persons using the premises on any particular day for any sporting or recreational activity were, on that day, members of the club."

(2) <u>Subsection (1)</u> of this section shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1981 (being the date of the commencement of the Sale of Liquor Amendment Act 1980).
