TARIFF BILL.

Hon. Sir W. J. STEWARD, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Schedule A, page 15, item "Lace, and laces, all kinds, 25 per cent.": Delete the words "and laces."

Schedule A, page 21, item "Cash registering machines, 20 per cent.": Strike out this item with a view to placing it on the free list.

Schedule A, page 23, item "Grain, and pulse, of every kind, when ground or in any way manufactured, not otherwise enumerated, including wheat flour, one shilling the 100 lb.": Insert after the words "wheat flour" the words "invoiced at or under £10 (over £10, free)."

Schedule A, page 23, item "Potatoes, £1 the ton": Insert after the word "Potatoes" the words "invoiced at or under £5 per ton (over £5, free)."

Schedule B, page 35: Insert next after item "Cocoa or cacao butter," &c., the following additional items, viz.: "Flour invoiced at over £10 per ton," "Potatoes invoiced at over £5 per ton."

Schedule B, page 29, next after item "Card clothing," &c.: Insert "Cash registering machines."

Schedule B, page 30, next after item "Tinsmiths' fittings," &c.: Insert "Typewriters."
