TOWN DISTRICTS BILL.

Mr. ELL, in Committee, to move the following new clauses:—

Repeal.

A. Sections seventeen and eighteen of the principal Act are hereby repealed.

Qualification of elector.

B. The qualifications of an elector shall be those prescribed by the Municipal Corporations Act, 1900, for electors under that Act.

Mode of election.

C. (1.) The members of the Board shall be elected by the electors of the district in the manner prescribed by the Local Elections Act, 1904, all the provisions of which Act shall apply.

(2.) Every such elector shall have one vote and no more.

Section 19 of principal Act amended.

D. Section nineteen of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing the words "from the aforesaid electoral rolls of ridings of counties," and also the words "and shall enter therein the number of votes which each elector is entitled to."
