Taxation (Annual Rates and Urgent Measures) Bill

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 3 Bills

Hon Dr Michael Cullen, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, and *Part 1* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, and the *Part 1* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title**
This Act is the Taxation (Annual Rates of Income Tax 2005–06) Act **2005**.
- 2 Commencement**
This Act comes into force on the day on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 2*, *Part 4*, and the *Schedule* be a separate Bill, and that the following enacting words and clauses be inserted before the *Part 2* heading:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title**
This Act is the Taxation (Urgent Measures) Act **2005**.
- 2 Commencement**
This Act comes into force on the day on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 3* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 3* heading and *clause 7* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Student Loan Scheme Amendment Act **2005**.
- (2) In this Act, the Student Loan Scheme Act 1992¹ is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
