VICTORIA COLLEGE BILL.

Rt. Hon. R. J. SEDDON, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 35, (a): In subparagraph (ii.), after the words "fourteen years of age," insert the words "on the first day of the month in which the examination is held."

Clause 35, (b): At the commencement of subparagraph (v.), insert "In and after the year one thousand nine hundred and six."

Clause 35, (e): Omit all words after "Where" in line 3 to "abode" in line 5.

To insert the following new clause:—

35A. (1.) The Council may, with the consent of the Minister of Education, extend the term during which any of the Queen's Scholarships awarded before the eighteenth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and three (being the date of the passing of "The Queen's Scholarships Act, 1303"), are held at a secondary school or its equivalent, provided that the whole term during which any scholarship is held at a secondary school or its equivalent does not exceed *four* years; and may modify the prescribed conditions of this Act accordingly.

(2.) Except as provided by this section, nothing in this Act shall affect any scholarship granted before the above-mentioned date.
