**Volunteers Employment Protection Amendment Bill**

*Proposed motion to divide Bill into 2 Bills*

Hon Mark Burton, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 1A, Part 1, and Schedules 1 to 4* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, *clauses 1 to 3, and the heading to Part 1* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Volunteers Employment Protection Amendment Act **2004**.
- (2) In this Act, the Volunteers Employment Protection Act 1973<sup>1</sup>, is called “the principal Act”.

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on 1 April 2004.

That *Part 2* be a separate Bill, and that for the heading to *Part 2*, and *clauses 18 and 19* there be substituted the following enacting words, and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Defence Amendment Act **2004**.
- (2) In this Act, the Defence Act 1990<sup>2</sup> is called “the principal Act”.

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on 1 April 2004.
