## VIOLENT OFFENCES BILL (NO. 2)

*Proposed Motion to Divide the Bill into 8 Bills*

Right Hon. GEOFFREY PALMER, in Committee, to move as follows:

That clauses 2 and 3 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 2 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

**An Act to amend the Arms Act 1983**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Arms Amendment Act 1987, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Arms Act 1983 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of August 1987.

That clauses 4 to 8 and the First Schedule be a separate Bill, and that for clause 4 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

**An Act to amend the Crimes Act 1961**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Crimes Amendment Act (No. 7) 1987, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Crimes Act 1961 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of August 1987.

That clauses 9 to 17 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 9 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

**An Act to amend the Criminal Justice Act 1985**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Criminal Justice Amendment Act (No. 4) 1987, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Criminal Justice Act 1985 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of August 1987.

That clauses 18 and 19 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 18 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

**An Act to amend the Local Government Act 1974**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Local Government Amendment Act (No. 6) 1987, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Local Government Act 1974 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of August 1987.

That clauses 20 to 22 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 20 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

**An Act to amend the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs Amendment Act (No. 2) 1987, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of August 1987.

That clauses 23 and 24 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 23 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

**An Act to amend the Summary Offences Act 1981**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Summary Offences Amendment Act (No. 3) 1987, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Summary Offences Act 1981 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of August 1987.

That clauses 25 to 32 and the Second Schedule be a separate Bill, and that for clause 25 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

**An Act to amend the Summary Proceedings Act 1957**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Summary Proceedings Amendment Act (No. 4) 1987, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Summary Proceedings Act 1957 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of August 1987.

That clauses 33 to 46 be a separate Bill with the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

**An Act to make better provision for the treatment of victims of criminal offences**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Victims of Offences Act 1987.

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of November 1987.
