WELLINGTON CITY DRAINAGE EMPOWERING BILL.

Mr. DUTHIE to move, in Committee, the following new clause:—

The provisions of sections thirty-three to thirty-six, both inclusive, of "The Public Works Acts Amendment Act, 1887," shall extend and apply to any case in which any compensation may become payable by the Corporation in respect of any land, situate within or without the city, taken by it for any purpose in connection with drainage or sanitation, or in respect of any damage done by reason of the construction or use of any work, either within or without the city, constructed by it for any such purpose, the Corporation being deemed substituted for the Minister, the Governor, and the Government respectively, and the provisoes at the end of sections thirty-three and thirty-six being deemed omitted.
