WESTPORT HARBOUR BOARD BILL.

The Hon. Sir J. VOGEL, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 1: To add the words “which is hereby incorporated with this Act.”

Clause 7: To omit the words “paid by the persons receiving the same to the Board,” and to substitute “paid to the Board in manner as the Governôr shall direct.”

To add the following proviso to the clause: “Provided that nothing in this section contained shall be deemed to give the Board any authority or control over the railway wharf at Westport, nor authorize the said Board to alter any charges or tolls leviabie thereat, but the said wharf shall remain under the administration of the authority having control of the railway to which the said wharf is annexed.”

GREYMOUTH HARBOUR BOARD BILL.
